IPSA Andhra Pradesh chapter Award for best M.V.Sc. Dissertation

1. Sponsor

Andhra Pradesh chapter of IPSA, Hyderabad.

2. Objectives of the Award

- To recognize the outstanding original research done by Master degree students in the discipline of **Poultry Science**
- To encourage high quality post-graduate research in priority areas of poultry science

3. Nature of the Award

- This award is meant exclusively for Master thesis in Poultry Science discipline from any Indian University/ Research Institution. **Every year one M.V.Sc. thesis** will be awarded.
- The individual award will consist of a **certificate (to the candidate as well as to the Guide), citation and cash prize of Rs. 4000/- and a medal** made of silver having gold plating.

4. Eligibility

- For every year of award, the thesis should be approved during January to December of preceding calendar year (e.g., Thesis approved from 1.1.2019 to 31.12.2019 will be considered for award in 2020, and so on and so forth).
- The dissertation work should be a part of the Master's programme that leads to M.V.Sc. degree in Poultry Science.
- The research work must be original and must have a direct bearing on some relevant aspects of the poultry production, health or management systems.
- The results obtained should have the potential of enhancing the production/ productivity/ sustainability of the Poultry production/ management system or substantially advance our knowledge.

5. Evaluation Criteria

- The thesis to be evaluated will be awarded marks in ratio of 70 (for Thesis): 20 (for Publication/ patents applied) :10 (for academic qualification)
- The thesis will be evaluated on following basis
 - Conceptual clarity, Scientific, technological and socio-economic relevance and priority of the research problem.
 - Compilation, analysis and interpretation of existing literature, quality of illustrations and photographs
 - Organization of research work. Complementarily of the various experiments and investigations and their integration into a logical

- plan of work.
- Conduct of the research programmes: Scientific soundness and technological modernity of the experimental methods and logical planning
- Scientific validity and accuracy of the analysis of experimental data.
- Principal findings: To what extent do they meet the objectives of the research programme.
- In what way the findings constitute a significant advancement in the existing knowledge and understanding or help improve productivity and sustainability
- Publication will be awarded marks on their quality as judged by the NAAS rating of the awarding year.
- Academic qualification will be evaluated based on marks obtained/ OGPA in graduation and post-graduation.

6. Procedure

IPSA Dr D. Choudhury Award for best Doctoral Dissertation

1. Sponsor

2. Objectives of the Award

- To recognize the outstanding original research done by Doctoral degree students in the discipline of Poultry Science.
- To encourage high quality post-graduate research in priority areas of poultry science.

3. Nature of the Award

- Every year one Ph.D. thesis will be awarded.
- The individual award will consist of a **certificate (to the candidate as well to the Guide), citation, cash prize of Rs. 5000/- and a medal** made of silver having gold plating.

4. Eligibility

- This award is meant exclusively for Doctoral thesis in Poultry Science discipline from any Indian University/ Research Institution.
- For every year of award, the thesis should be approved during January to December of preceding calendar year (e.g., Thesis approved from 1.1.2019 to 31.12.2019 will be considered for award in 2020, and so on and so forth).
- The research work must be original and must have a direct bearing on some relevant aspects of the Poultry production, health or management systems.
- The results obtained should have the potential of enhancing the production/ productivity/sustainability of the Poultry production/management system or substantially advance our knowledge.
- Only the publications accepted/ published out of Ph.D. dissertation work will be considered. Articles submitted for publication and Abstracts will not be considered.

5. Evaluation Criteria

- The thesis to be evaluated will be awarded marks in ratio of 70 (for Thesis): 20 (for Publication/patents applied) :10 (for academic qualification)
- The thesis will be evaluated on following basis
 - Conceptual clarity, Scientific, technological and socio-economic relevance and priority of the research problem
 - Compilation, analysis and interpretation of existing literature,

- quality of illustrations and photographs
- Organization of research work. Complementarily of the various experiments and investigations and their integration into a logical plan of work
- Conduct of the research programmes: Scientific soundness and technological modernity of the experimental methods and logical planning
- Scientific validity and accuracy of the analysis of experimental data
- Principal findings: To what extent do they meet the objectives of the research programme
- In what way the findings constitute a significant advance in our knowledge and understanding or help improve productivity and sustainability.
- Publication will be awarded marks on their quality as judged by the NAAS rating
- Academic qualification will be evaluated based on marks obtained /OGPA in graduation and post-graduation.

6. Procedure

Applications for the award made in the prescribed application proforma obtainable free of cost from the IPSA web site (www.ipsa-cari.org.in), IPSA Head Office, will be accepted on or before the prescribed last date. The duly filled "Proforma of Application" along with scanned copies of all annexures, in pdf format, may be sent to General Secretary/ Joint Secretary of IPSA at CARI, Izatnagar. The Judging Committee will screen the Applications, identify the outstanding entries, and make recommendations to the IPSA along with the draft citations.

7. Administration of the Award

- There shall be a Committee consisting of at least 3 expert members from different disciplines of poultry sciences for evaluation of entries.
- The duly constituted committee will screen the applications and make recommendations to the IPSA HQ along with the draft citations for approval.

8. Presentation

The presentation of award will be made in the IPSA conference. The awardees will give a presentation of about 10 min. on salient achievements.

IPSA Avitech Young Scientist Award & IPSA Young Scientist Award

1. Genesis of the award

- The award has been instituted by M/s Avitech Animal Health, Gurgaon by contributing Rs. 50,000/-. The award will be presented out of the interest accrued from its fixed deposit.
- During GB of IPSACON at Chennai, it was decided to confer three Young Scientist Awards to three candidates, on merit.
- The first candidate in merit will be awarded with **IPSA Avitech Young Scientist Award**, comprising of a certificate, a cash prize of Rs. 2500/- and a medal.
- Next two candidates in merit will be awarded with **IPSA Young Scientist Award**, sponsored by IPSA and comprising of a **certificate, a medal and cash prize of Rs 1500/- and Rs 1000/-**, respectively.

2. Who can apply

- The Candidate must be a life member of Indian Poultry science Association.
- The age of the candidate must not exceed 35 years as on 31st December of the awarding year.

3. Award guidelines

- The award will be given based on the bonafide research work on any aspects of Poultry science carried out by the candidate.
- The Candidate must present the research work personally in the conference of the association.
- The research work / candidate once awarded will not be considered further.

4. Administration of the Award

- The award will be conferred on selected abstracts/ candidates during the IPSACON after the presentation made by candidate.
- The award shall be decided by a committee comprising of at least three experts including one representative of Avitech Animal Health Pvt. Ltd. Gurgaon, if available. The decision of the committee shall be final and binding to the candidates.
- Committee has the right not to recommend, if no suitable candidate is found fit for the award.
- No TA/DA will be given to the candidate for receiving the award and its presentation in the annual conference of IPSA.

- Every year **two** awards, one for male and one for female presenters, will be awarded. The individual award will consist of a **certificate, a medal and cash prize of Rs 2500/=**.
- Travelling Allowance, on actuals but limited to III AC, will be given to the selected candidates by the Organizing Secretary, IPSACON, on production of original tickets/ documents.

4. Eligibility

- The Candidate contesting for the award must be the life member of Indian Poultry Science Association.
- The age of the candidate must not exceed 35 years as on 31st December of the awarding year.
- The award will be given based on the bonafide research work on any aspects of Poultry science carried out by the candidate.
- The Candidate must present the research work personally in the conference of the association.
- The research work / candidate once awarded will not be considered further.

5. Administration of the Award

- The award will be conferred on selected abstracts/ candidates during the IPSACON after the presentation made by candidate.
- The award shall be decided by a committee comprising of at least three experts. The decision of the committee shall be final and binding to the candidates.
- Committee has the right not to recommend, if no suitable candidate is found suitable for the award.

- The award carries a **certificate and cash prize of Rs.1000/-**.

2. Administration of the Award

- The award is given on a research paper published in IJPS in the area of Poultry Genetics and Breeding in each year.
- No separate application is required.

Fellow of Indian Poultry Science Association for the year (IPSA Fellow)

Guidelines for Fellowship

1. Eligibility

The applicant should have at least ten years of standing as Life Member of IPSA and with 20 years of professional experience, of which 5 years should be as a University Professor, Principal Scientist or equivalent position in teaching, research and extension education as on 31st December of the year for which the Fellowship is to be granted (e.g., 31st December 2020 will be the cutoff date for candidates applying for the Fellow-2020 and so on and so forth)

2. Procedure

Applications in the prescribed proforma, obtainable from the IPSA web site (www.ipsa-cari.org.in) will be accepted on or before the prescribed last date only. The duly filled "Application Proforma" along with scanned copies of all annexures, in pdf format, may be sent to General Secretary/ Joint Secretary at following address: Dr. J.S. 3. Evaluation criteria

- The outstanding achievements and sustained significant contributions in the field of poultry sciences are the determining criteria for electing IPSA Fellows.

- The applicant must provide appropriate proof/ documents to support his/her claim.

4. Administration of the Award

- There shall be a Committee consisting of at least 3 expert members from different disciplines of poultry sciences for evaluation of entries.
- The duly constituted committee will screen the applications, based on the score card given below and make recommendations to the IPSA HQ along with the draft citations for approval.
- Minimum qualifying marks: 70
- The selected candidates will be required to pay Rs. 5000/- towards processing fee.
- The individual award will consist of a **certificate, citation and a medal**.
