Agenda#3: *Presentation of the Treasurer's Report for 2024*

Dr Jaydip Rokade, presented the Treasurer's Report for the FY 2023-24, prepared by the CA. He informed that the IPSA was having total assets worth Rs.3839359.06/- as on 31.3.2024.

Agenda#4: *Presentation of the report of the Chief Editor, IJPS for 2024*

Agenda#5: Presentation of the report of the Admin, IPSA website

Agenda#7: Conducting the regular quiz in the field of Poultry Science at the national level every year

Dr Amitav Bhattacharya, Associate Professor, DUVASU, Mathura proposed to conduct quiz in the field of Poultry Science to popularise the discipline amongst students. The proposal was accepted in principle.

Agenda#8: Finalization of venue for the 40th IPSACON-2025

Dr. J.S. Tyagi, GS, IPSA informed the house about the two proposals received for hosting IPSACON-2025, i.e., Dr. T.N. Krishnamurthy, Veterinary College, Bengaluru and Dr. U. Raj Kumar, ICAR-DPR, Hyderabad. Having detailed deliberations on the issue, the GB finalized the venue of the 40th IPSACON at Hyderabad to be hosted by the DPR, Hyderabad.

Agenda#9: Proposal to nominate the Director, DPR, as one of the Vice Presidents

Dr MVLN Raju, PS, DPR, Hyderabad proposed to nominate the Director, DPR, Hyderabad as one of the Vice Presidents of IPSA.
